WOW! What a year this has been! I know God is doing some great things through us and the enemy is not happy about it as we're definitely under attack. However, I also know God is still on the throne and will see us through every challenge. How do I know this? Because His Word tells me so! Jeremiah 29:11, my favorite verse, says: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Another translation uses the words "and a good end." I'll take it either way as God's promise to His children. When we pray to release God to have His way in every situation of our lives, we have to trust that whether we are experiencing what we believe to be good or bad, God is at work, ultimately working everything together for our good. Romans 8:28.

There are times when I get so frustrated that the enemy is keeping me from working on the online version of the CTC program by starting fires in things that on the surface have nothing to do with the ministry but rob me of time and money we can ill afford to lose. In these times, I have to remind myself that God knows the end that I can't yet see. He is already at peace because He knows it will work to our good. It does me little good to fret or worry about things that are out of my control; instead, I must trust that God will give us the victory.

When I paused to examine our accomplishments this past year, I can easily understand why the enemy has set his face against us. A year ago, at this time we had **1360** students in our CTC in-class program and no online program. Today we have **1413** in-class students and **12** online students for a total of **1425** an increase of **65** over last year. Additionally, we had **3229** graduates as of December 2018 and this year we presently have **3506** an increase of **277** graduates in 2019. Can someone shout Hallelujah, Praise the LORD!!!!!

To add insult to injury to our enemy, consider the three new churches we dedicated in Malawi in 2019! Plus the new church for Pastor Francis Ntotela just beginning construction, and the much larger church for Pastor Samuel Mtaula in Mozambique still under construction. That congregation is multiplying so fast

that, once completed, will likely be holding multiple services. I'll share more on that next month. Plus, there are the 6 churches we completed and dedicated in the Philippines this year, all with growing congregations.

Pastor Francis, a CTC graduate and the director of one of our CTC locations, pastors a church in Jali Village, Malawi, that was destroyed in a storm. I asked for your help in replacing the mud



brick church with a good, fired-brick building with a sheet metal roof. I released the funds we had so they could get started. We are still about \$3500 short of completing this project!
